¹⁷ So [the Pharisees] said again to the blind man, “What do you say about [Jesus], since he has opened your eyes?” He said, “He is a prophet” (John 9:17).

³⁰ The [blind] man answered, “Why, this is an amazing thing! You do not know where he comes from, and yet he opened my eyes. ³¹ We know that God does not listen to sinners... ³³ If this man were not from God, he could do nothing” (John 9:30-33).

³⁵ Jesus...having found [the blind man] he said, “Do you believe in the Son of Man?” ³⁶ ... “And who is he, sir, that I may believe in him?” ³⁷ Jesus said to him, “You have seen him, and it is he who is speaking to you.”

³⁸ He said, “Lord, I believe,” and he worshiped him (John 9:35-38).
