1) Were Jesus recognized as he deserves, <u>all of creation</u> would have <u>travelled</u> <u>to see him</u>.

⁶Oh come, let us worship and bow down; let us kneel before the Lord, our Maker!

⁷For he is our God, and we are the people of his pasture, and the sheep of his hand.

Today, if you hear his voice, ⁸ do not harden your hearts, as at Meribah, as on the day at Massah in the wilderness...

(Psalm 95:6-8)

2) Even when <u>unappreciated</u>, <u>unwelcome</u>, or <u>ignored</u>, Jesus still came to save.

⁵ Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, ⁶ who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, ⁷ but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. ⁸ And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. (*Philippians 2:5–8*)
